MORE THAN 15 MILLION IN THE UK WILL SUFFER FROM HEARING LOSS BY 2035

The national UK charity Action on Hearing Loss (AOHL) estimates that one-in-five British people (15.6 million) will suffer from a hearing loss of at least 25dB in their better ear by 2035. The World Health Organization (WHO) predicts hearing loss to be among the top 10 disease burdens in the UK by 2030.

Hearing loss is already a major issue
Today more than 11 million people across the UK suffer from hearing loss, which translates to about one-in-six British people. Around 900,000 people in the UK suffer from severe or profound hearing

loss, meaning that they have a hearing loss of at least 70dB in their better ear.

Previous studies have shown that only 45% of people with hearing loss in the UK use hearing aids even though it could be beneficial.
